## ORDINANCE NUMBER NO. 02-2007

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DUTIES OF THE OFFICES OF RECORDER AND TREASURER; SETTING FORTH THE SALARY OF RECORDER TREASURER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

## NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN, ARKANSAS:

<u>Section One</u>. The offices of Recorder and Treasurer have been and shall continue to be combined into a single office under the authority of Arkansas Code Annotated 14-44-114.

<u>Section Two.</u> In addition to the duties specifically established by Arkansas Code and the Arkansas Constitution, the recorder/ treasurer shall perform the following duties:

- 1. Have the custody of all the laws and ordinances of the city;
- Keep a regular and correct journal of the proceedings of the city council;
- Arranging the publication of official duties such as request for bids, conducting of public hearings, ordinances, elections and so;
- Perform the functions of a magistrate during the disability or absence of the mayor, with all the power and jurisdiction of the mayor, to all intents and purposes whatever.
- maintain and supervise the financial records of the City, to include but not limited to signing checks and authorizing other disbursements for City accounts.

Section Three. The Recorder/ Treasurer shall receive the salary as Recorder/ Treasurer of \$ 100.00 per month.

Section Four. All ordinances or part of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

<u>Section Five</u>. An Emergency is hereby declared to exist in that it shall become effective immediately upon passage of this ordinance.
