ORDINANCE No. <u>03</u>-2017

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING TRUCK ROUTES THROUGH AND WITHIN THE CITY OF AUSTIN, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, it being necessary for the citizens of the City of Austin, Arkansas (the "City") to be safe in all manners and aspects, and

WHEREAS, designated truck routes being necessary for the safety of citizens and for the preservation of infrastructure;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN, ARKANSAS, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- All through trucks or any vehicle hauling natural resources shall be prohibited from residential streets, unless specifically allowed herein. Any truck using a residential street in a manner not prescribed in this section shall be in violation of this chapter. Trucks making local deliveries or with places of business in the above designated areas are hereby excluded from the requirements of this section.
- 2. Trucks in excess of one ton are hereby prohibited from traveling on all streets within the City of Austin, with the exception of Arkansas State Highway 367, Arkansas State Highway 305, and Arkansas State Highway 38, except for the purposes of local pickup and/or delivery or when such vehicle is owned by a resident of the subdivision and is temporarily garaged or parked at the owner's residence.
- EMERGENCY CLAUSE: Whereas, this Ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of the public health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
