

ORDINANCE NO. 04-2008

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANY ELECTED OR APPOINTED CITY OFFICIAL FROM HIRING A FAMILY MEMBER TO A POSITION DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY RESPONSIBLE TO SUCH OFFICIAL.

SECTION A:

That no elected or appointed official in the City of Austin may hire a member of his/her family to a position directly or indirectly responsible to such official. For the purpose of this section, member of family shall be defined as Mother, Father, Son, Daughter, Husband, Wife, Brother, Sister, Mother-In-Law, Father-In-Law, Brother-In-Law, Sister-In-Law, Uncle, Aunt, Nephew, Niece, First Cousin, Grandfather, Grandmother, Grandson, Granddaughter, Step-children, and Step-parents. In addition, no person may be hired if a member of his/her family has supervisory authority over that employee.

SECTION B:

Family members or members of family as defined herein who are currently or presently employed by the city of Austin may remain at those current or present positions of jobs.

SECTION C:

That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed and hold for naught.
