ORDINANCE NO. 10, 2002

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SETTING PROPERTY TAX RATES TO BE COLLECTED IN 2003 FOR THE CITY OF AUSTIN, ARKANSAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN,

ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The property tax rate to be collected in 2003 for the City of Austin is hereby levied at .005 mills.

Section 2. Application of millage:

Section 3. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 4. Emergency. Whereas the proper operation of the City of Austin is of great importance to its residents and the safety and protection of its citizens, and this Ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of the public health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
